Ratings	Trainee, ES	When a Module Item is considered achieved, both the trainee & ES should rate a Module Item (e.g. RGN1, CLP 3 etc), 1 x only, as "Achieved" and add supporting text to explain why/how this was achieved. *Although there is an option for the trainee/ES to select "Not achieved", it is discouraged to utilize this wording. *If you are in an "in-work experience" module, then you can expect to see a WPBA and overall reflection. *If you achieved via an PMST approved external modular course (EMC), the only evidence expected in the e-portfolio is: • EMC course pass letter • Trainee reflection on the EMC • And both the Trainee and ES have rated as achieved	Each year, in preparation for an ARCP, both the trainee and ES should rate each Specialty CiP (#1-8) as Level 1-4 and add supporting text to justify their rating. For each Generic CiP (#9-14), rate each CiP by anchor statements: (Below, Meets, Above) expectations. *By the end of ST6, all CiPs are expected to be Level 4 In order to complete PMST. *A rating of Level 4 achieved in a CiP in ST3,4 or 5 year – does not necessarily equate to a rating of Level 4 in the following ST year. Each year the trainee should provide evidence to justify that rating.

Evidence in the e-portfolio	Trainee	This should include combination of WPBAs, standalone evidence and reflections and overall module reflections. *Once an overall module has been rated as achieved, new evidence for that module is not required, but of course can be added. *Attending revision courses should not be linked as evidence in the curriculum. However, the DPM pass letter should be uploaded into the "Profile / Certificates and Exams" section of the e-portfolio.	This should include combination of WPBAs, standalone evidence and reflections and overall CiP reflection for each ST year. *Even if a Level 4 has been achieved in a prior ST year, new evidence is needed in the e-portfolio to justify each CiP rating for the current year.
Personal Development Plan (PDP)	Trainee	 Strongly recommend putting into place: at the start of each ST year (and then can rate as achieved/not achieved at the end of each ST year).
